## A Bar at the Folies Bergère Acrylics on canvas 70 x 89 cm Available

Painted in early 2011, this work is a vibrant homage to Manet's celebrated scene, reimagined through my distinctive palette of the time. The barmaid's gaze meets the viewer across a shimmering expanse of color and movement, merging realism with expressive abstraction. For me, this painting marked an exploration of how classical subjects can be infused with contemporary energy.



3 O'Clock

Part of the same creative period, 3 O'Clock captures a figure adrift between reverie and surrender. The bold contrasts and saturated hues were my response to the tension between stillness and inner turbulence. This canvas was an exercise in how light can become a psychological force.

Nonchaloir translates as "indifference," yet the seated figure radiates quiet introspection.

Here, I worked to balance the luminous warmth of the draped fabric against the cool reserve of her posture. This piece remains one of my personal reflections on solitude and poise.



## Promenade on the Beach Acrylics on canvas 100 x 100 cm Available

In this vibrant composition, two women move across a shoreline rendered in sweeping color. Painted at the culmination of this series, Promenade on the Beach was an exploration of motion and memory—a celebration of fleeting moments under vast skies.
